
Year 1 descriptive fiction writing


Context:

Children had read the story 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. In previous lessons, they wrote a description of the magic beans and the giant's castle. The children made a class mind map of adjectives to describe Jack's feelings and used these to write their own sentences.
