Thank you for your continued support as we work through such difficult times.



## IF YOUR CHILD DEVELOPS COVID SYMPTOMS



### What to do if anyone else in your house has symptoms or a positive test

If you, or any other adult in your household, have symptoms or tests positive then you must isolate for ten days. All other members of the household must isolate for 14 days even if they do not have any symptoms.

**DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL.**

### If a pupil or adult in your child's class tests positive

We will contact you and inform you that your child's class is being sent home and that your child will have to isolate for 14 days. **Other members of the household do not need to self-isolate unless your child develops symptoms.** If your child develops symptoms they must get tested.
