Dear parents and carers,

Thank you for helping us to keep the roads around school safe. We have seen a big improvement in keeping the dipped pavement areas and our zigzags clear!

Breakfast Club

We are now full for breakfast club for working families. All children must be brought to the hall door and signed in. We can only take one or two children in emergencies if they are booked in beforehand; we cannot accept children brought to the door and left at 8am. There is a daily £1 charge.

ParentPay

We now expect parents to pay for dinners, uniform and school trips via Parentpay. We are running a 'help' session to support families download the app, register and log in on Frday 20th October at 9.00am. Please come along if you need some support to use the app.

Swimming

We are lucky enough to be taking Yr 4 swimming every week as part of the National Curriculum to the University of Birmingham swimming pool, which is an amazing venue! The children are learning the lifesaving skills of performing safe self-rescue and swimming 25 metres. This could save your child's life! Yr 4 will continue with swimming lessons until December, then Yr 5 will continue with these session from January to May. After this Yr 6 will swim to ensure we have as many children leaving Clifton being able to swim 25m.
