Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had a wonderful start to the school year – just over a week to go until the half term break so we wanted to share some important updates.

New Values Awards

Our school values are **Respect, Care and Listen.** We have now introduced a 'Values' award for one child in every class, once per half term. This prestigious award will be given to a child who has shown respect, kindness and who can actively listen and make good choices. The award consists of a certificate and a £10 Amazon voucher. Parents will be invited in to watch their child being given the award in assemblies.



Punctuality and signing in late procedures

Please be aware the gates close at 8.35am. If you bring your child in after this time, they will need to be signed in late as teachers will have already taken the register in class. We appreciate that sometimes, signing children in late on our electronic system can create a queue. From Monday, we are changing our procedures so that we have two members of staff signing late children in on the door – parents do not need to come into reception. It is essential you wait with your child until they are safely signed in. Our Family Hub team will be talking to families who are persistently late and identifying ways to support them. *Please do your best to ensure your children are at school on time so they don't miss important learning.*

Young PCSOs



You may be aware that we have several children trained to be Young PCSOs and they give out Warning Tickets to cars parked illegally or dangerously. *This includes the dipped pavements on White Street* which are there so that pushchair or wheelchair users can cross safely. If you are parked dangerously and receive a ticket, please accept this politely and do not argue with the member of staff in front of the children. The children have been trained by the police so know exactly who they can give tickets to. They are giving up their time after school to be responsible and active citizens to make the roads around school safer and we do not expect our

pupils to see rude or poor behaviour from parents towards our staff. *Please remember to park considerately.* Thank you.
