Uniform

Please remember that we encourage children to dress for an active day in **black**, **plain** leggings or joggers with a red Clifton T shirt and a red jumper or cardigan with **black**, **plain** trainers. Sports brands or jeans should not be worn and if your child chooses to wear a headscarf, these should be grey or black. You may receive a letter from your child's class teacher if they are not wearing their correct uniform. If you have any worries about uniform, please come and see a member of the Family Hub Team. Remember, we run a Deposit Closet each half term where you can collect preloved uniform for free.

Snacks and Packed Lunches

We promote healthy eating and choices at Clifton and we are a nut free school. We do provide a portion of fresh bagel for each child every morning and free fruit is provided for Nursery, Reception and Key Stage 1. Currently, we do allow a mid morning snack to be brought in from home. Ideally this should be fruit or a healthy snack bar (no nuts). A small packet of crisps (not family size) is also allowed or a small chocolate bar such as a KitKat (again, no nuts). However, we have been noticing that sweets and lollipops are being brought in as snacks. **Sweets are not allowed in school at all.** Thank you for your support.
